- **Northern Rivers (Northeast Parent and Child)**, residential treatment program, received sweats, dress clothes, t-shirts, sneakers, boots, winter jackets, backpacks and hangers.
- Six chicken dinners were given to the **EMTs** who brought their ambulance and spent the day on Friday with us. **Guardian House**, a shelter for women veterans, also received 6 meals.
- The children of the community enjoyed free pony rides, a petting zoo and a reptile exhibit.
- Sleeping bags were given to **Shelters of Saratoga**.
- **City Mission** received many bags of clothing and linens and many boxes of household goods.
- **Young Parents United**, which supports single parents in Schenectady, set up a table to share information about their program. We gave them many bags of baby clothing, towels, bedding, furniture, toys, strollers, porta cribs, booster seats, and household goods.
- Free Medical Equipment to the community.
- Food from our church pantry was given away.
- **Birthright** was given bags of baby clothes, blankets and towels.
- A local **animal shelter** received blankets and towels.
- **ECAR, which stands for Every Campus Is A Refuge**, received clothing , linens and household goods.
- Luggage was given to a group supporting migrants.
- **Alplaus UMC Knitting group** received yarn for their knitting club.
- Fabric went to **Florida Church Women** to make clothing for children in Africa.
- **The Salvation Army Soup Kitchen** received winter clothing to be given away on Wednesdays.
- **Grass Root Givers**, a non profit in Albany, received books to give to children, families, prisons and underserved communities in the capital district.
