**Sunday Bible Study** A Bible study on Moses began last Sunday, and will continue for 5 more weeks, at 9:00 AM in the Fireside Room. Dick Chatterton is leading the study using the book and video, *Moses; In the Footsteps of the Reluctant Prophet*, by Adam Hamilton. You may still sign up and purchase a book for \$12 in the church office.

**The Early Birds Study** is held every Monday at 9 AM. We will be studying 8 major themes of the Bible. Materials will be provided. We will not meet on Monday holidays: 10/14 and 11/11.

**Explorers Bible Study** is held every Wednesday at 9:30 AM. Each week, we watch a 30-minute video on some aspect of Christianity. This year's study is entitled *The World of Biblical Israel*, by Professor Cynthia R. Chapman. The course traces the history of biblical Israel from its origins (1200 B.C.) to its emergence as a nation, and then, to a pair of kingdoms. It continues with its conquests by Assyria and Babylon, and finally, their return to Israel. Each week's session can be viewed on its own, so you need not attend every week.
