The World is Our Parish Social Action in the history of Methodism. Wednesday, February 2, at 7PM. This program and discussion will look at highlights of the history of the people called Methodist over nearly 250 years, specifically in the ways that churches in the Methodist movement have responded to poverty, war, and injustice. John Wesley, whose ministry gave rise to Methodism, famously said, "I consider the world to be my parish." Wesley was deeply concerned with the injustice of slavery and the slave trade, and in the generations since Wesley, Methodists have lived out our faith in responding to human needs and societal injustices: child labor; the effects of alcohol and gambling on children and families; unsafe working conditions; and a host of other human issues. All are welcome to this evening of learning and discussion, as we continue to discern how God leads us to respond to needs in our own time, living out our faith in Jesus Christ.

There will be a special Charge Conference as part of our regular Council meeting on February 15, to consider removal of individuals from official membership. Today's Scripture: Luke 4:21-30

²¹ Then he began to say to them, "Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."

²² All spoke well of him and were amazed at the gracious words that came from his mouth. They said, "Is not this Joseph's son?"

²³ He said to them, "Doubtless you will quote to me this proverb, 'Doctor, cure yourself!' And you will say, 'Do here also in your hometown the things that we have heard you did at Capernaum.'"

²⁴ And he said, "Truly I tell you, no prophet is accepted in the prophet's hometown."

²⁵ But the truth is, there were many widows in Israel in the time of Elijah, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, and there was a severe famine over all the land;

²⁶ yet Elijah was sent to none of them except to a widow at Zarephath in Sidon.

²⁷ There were also many lepers in Israel in the time of the prophet Elisha, and none of them was cleansed except Naaman the Syrian."

²⁸ When they heard this, all in the synagogue were filled with rage.

²⁹ They got up, drove him out of the town, and led him to the brow of the hill on which their town was built, so that they might hurl him off the cliff.

³⁰ But he passed through the midst of them and went on his way.


